Have plans for visits from Scovill Zoo, Aikman's Wildlife Center, Douglas-Hart Nature Center, among others. There will be crafts and science experiments as well. For 1st through 5th graders. ### Committee reports

Maybe need to contact someplace like Jack-a-Slab or Illini Concrete who might also look into our sidewalk issue that is and has been ongoing for some time. Might be able to get some grant money from the village? Adam will check into this idea.

Board dinner will be Saturday, April 27 at the Monarch in Monticello.

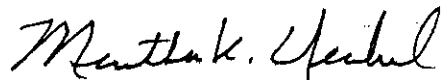
John congratulated the newly re-elected board members.
